
Topic: Cumulative Incident data

Staff Follow Up: According to the Final MSD Report Version, on page 262 (Section 8.3) the shooter's Discipline Records indicate that there had already been 125 incidents reported on this student. Ms. Rupert is asking how many other students in our District have accumulated large numbers of disciplinary actions/referrals. **(Rupert) #19-055**

Response:

Annually, the Student Assessment and Research (SAR) department within the Office of Academics (OoA) provides the School Board of Broward County (SBBC) with a report of *Incidents and Suspensions in Broward County Public Schools*. This report, and associated appendices, was most recently released on December 3, 2018. Each iteration of the report includes analysis of incidents, discipline actions and suspensions on the three previous school years. These reports can be found at <https://www.browardschools.com/Page/34771>.

The "Incidents and Suspensions" document is an annual "snapshot" report of the types of incidents and disciplinary actions taken summarized by district, grade band, and school location in the specified school year. Additionally, the comparisons include demographic factors and a three-year range of comparisons for determining trend lines.

In April of 2019, a SBBC board member asked for a distinct form of disciplinary analysis to be produced. The request was for a report that provides the number of students that have accumulated disciplinary infractions throughout their enrollment history in BCPS. In responding to this request, the OoA SAR team has developed the attached report which provides a summary of the cumulative number, and type, of disciplinary incidents recorded for each student. The report provides the number of students that have cumulative totals of student disciplinary incidents reported in ranges of 1-10, 11-20, 21-40, 41-99, and more than 100 incidents. The report detail provides cumulative incident totals for the district, grade band, and school by grade level.

A note of caution must be provided in what judgments or determinations should be inferred from this report. Every student who has a disciplinary incident is to receive both consequences and supports. Students identified as Students with Disabilities (SWD) and may or may not have the disciplinary incidents in their history related to their identified disability.

Students with a significant record of behavioral infractions *are not to be inferred as inherently dangerous to self or others*. The question of danger to self or others is determined through a threat assessment process which is conducted in a separate, though parallel process.

The Office of School Climate and Discipline, the Office of Support Services in the Exceptional Student Learning Supports Division, the Office of School Performance and Accountability all work with school administrations, each school's Collaborative Problem Solving team, and other school based personnel to ensure that each student is held to a common set of behavioral

expectations and is addressed in a personalized manner when patterns of disciplinary incidents occur.

The following points represent summary information of this analysis.

- 74.3% of all current students have not committed a single incident (Table 1)
- 53.3% of current 12th grade students have not committed a single incident (Table 1).
- 85.2% of all current students who are involved in incidents ($N=67,948$; $n=57,879$) have only committed 1-10 over their academic career (Table 1).
- Student incidents increase at the middle school grade levels (06 through 08) and decrease at the high school grade level (09 through 12) (Table 2).
- 75 Students that have accumulated 100 or more incidents across their academic career (Table 1).
- Each of the 75 students with 100 or more total incidents have had several different student interventions (Minimum of 15 Different Intervention Codes) (See Table 7 for a list of intervention codes).
- Of the 410,156 total accumulated incidents, 35,220 (8.6%) were SESEIR Incident Types (Table 2).
- 65.1% of students classified as a student with a disability (SWD) did not commit a single incident (Table 3).
- 52.0% of students that have accumulated 100 or more incidents over their academic career are classified as SWD (Table 3).

Cumulative incident data are provided below and, in the attachments, provided.

Method:

The data include students enrolled at the End of Year (EOY) for school year 2018-19 in Broward County Public Schools, including Charter Schools, Virtual Schools, and Agencies. Students' incidents included any incident they committed throughout their academic career (from school years 2000 through 2019).
