Lawsuits and Transfers of Funds/Property: Currently, only lawsuits with a Party or transfers of funds/property to a Party are counted as major decisions.

Issuance of Bonds or Debt: Should this be a major decision?	
Non-Uniform Rates or Fees: In most instances, rates and fees imposed by the Authority must be uniform across all Parties. Late-joining Parties or Parties that provide "extraordinary contributions" to the Authority may receive different rates.
